

Gift Aid Declaration form

Boost your donation by 25p of Gift Aid for every £1 you donate to the 10th Fife Scout Group



Gift Aid is reclaimed by the charity from the tax you pay for the current tax year. Your address is needed to identify you as a current UK taxpayer. These details are kept for 6 financial years after the last claim for any additional queries regarding your gift aid declaration.
